



Kindness Caterpillar



MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Construction paper: Green and 4 different colors of your liking
- Glue stick
- Markers
- Scissors
- Pipe Cleaner
- Goggly eyes or color pencil



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut out a leaf and a strip out of the green construction paper. Put aside once done.
2. Take your 4 different colored construction paper and cut into strips. Once cut, grab 4 strips of colored construction paper and fold them into small cylinders that will fit onto the leaf.
3. Choose one small colored cylinder for the face, glue/draw the eyes onto the face, and draw a smile(optional).
4. Glue the rest of the cylinders together in any order you like.
5. When dried, glue the last strip of paper on the underside of the caterpillar's head.
6. Then glue the bottom end of the caterpillar onto the round part of the leaf.
(The strip of paper should be sticking out.)
7. Lastly, cut the pipe cleaner about an 1 1/2 inches and then fold the pipe cleaner in half and glue the folded part onto the back of the caterpillar's head. (Optional: Twist the ends of the pipe cleaner to give shape to the antennas.)
8. Now pull the string and watch your caterpillar move!
