



Kindness Caterpillar

MATERIALS NEEDED:

 Construction paper: Green and 4 different colors of your liking

- Glue stick
- Markers
- Scissors
- Pipe Cleaner
- · Goggly eyes or color pencil

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut out a leaf and a strip out of the green construction paper. Put aside once done.
- 2. Take your 4 different colored construction paper and cut into strips. Once cut, grab 4 strips of colored construction paper and fold them into small cylinders that will fit onto the leaf.
- 3. Choose one small colored cylinder for the face, glue/draw the eyes onto the face, and draw a smile(optional).
- 4. Glue the rest of the cylinders together in any order you like.
- 5. When dried, glue the last strip of paper on the underside of the caterpillar's head.
- 6. Then glue the bottom end of the caterpillar onto the round part of the leaf. (The strip of paper should be sticking out.)
- 7. Lastly, cut the pipe cleaner about an 1 1/2 inches and then fold the pipe cleaner in half and glue the folded part onto the back of the caterpillar's head. (Optional: Twist the ends of the pipe cleaner to give shape to the antennas.)
- 8. Now pull the string and watch your caterpillar move!
